Happy Easter!! Did you know that Easter is not a single day, but an entire season encompassing eight Sundays? That's right! "Easter Day" is but the first day of a season that continues for 50 days, sometimes called "The Great Fifty Days," culminating on the Day of Pentecost, which is the 8th Sunday of Easter. This year the season of Easter stretches from Sunday, March 31 to Sunday, May 19th. Setting aside "Ordinary Time," the time between the Advent-Christmas and Lent-Easter cycles, (called "ordinary" because the Sundays are numbered with ordinal numbers), Easter is the longest season of the Christian Year—and appropriately so! As Laurence Hull Stookey puts it in his book *Calendar: Christ's Time for the Church*, "The explosive force of the resurrection of the Lord is too vast to be contained within the celebration of a single day."

When God created the earth and everything in it in Genesis 1, God rested on the 7th day—setting aside one-seventh of each week and calling it "holy". Likewise, in the Church, we set aside roughly one-seventh of the year as "holy" in our 50-Day celebration of the resurrection of our Lord. In Scripture, numbers hold great significance. The number 7 is highly revered as symbolizing fullness and perfection--completion. The number 8, on the other hand, goes a step beyond completion to "redemption." Not long after Jesus' resurrection, Christians began to break away from the Jewish tradition of holding Sabbath on the 7th day and observed their own celebrations on Sunday—the first day of the week, or, as the early Christians called it, the 8th day—the Day of Redemption—the day in which God inaugurated a new creation in Christ. The number 50 was likewise a significant number as it represented the year of Jubilee, an occasion for great joy as those who had been indentured and enslaved were liberated and given a new lease on life. Thus, we celebrate Easter for 50 days, encompassing eight Sundays—a season of redemption, liberation, and joy as we proclaim Jesus' resurrection and the inauguration of a new Kingdom in which Jesus Christ is Lord.

SPIRITUAL GIFTS SURVEY RESULTS

A huge “Thank You!” to everyone who took the Spiritual Gifts survey and turned in your results. If you haven’t taken it yet, contact the office for a link or pick up one of the paper copies in Ball Lounge and turn it into the office.

Below is a summary of our collective giftings. How blessed we are to have a congregation with such a diverse group of gifts! You will note that many people scored high in “Miracles” and “Healing.”

Note that in this particular survey, the gift of “Miracles” was interpreted as having a strong *belief* in miracles and “Healing” was interpreted as being a healing presence in others’ lives, not necessarily having the ability to bring about the physical healing of another through touch or prayer.

In most cases only the top three gifts were listed and, in a few cases, a different spiritual gift list or survey was used to the one distributed through the office. No doubt our congregation represents many more giftings than what is recorded here, but this gives us a snapshot of how richly God has blessed us!

MISSION TRIP TO MIDWEST MISSION DISTRIBUTION CENTER July 9-11, 2024

In July, you are invited to join us on a mission trip to the Midwest Mission Distribution Center in Pawnee, Illinois. We will drive down on Tuesday afternoon, spend Wednesday volunteering in the warehouse, and return home on Thursday. We will stay in their volunteer lodge, where we have reserved two rooms with a total of eight beds. Trip is first-come, first serve. If more than eight people are interested we will look into the possibility of reserving additional beds. The Midwest Mission Distribution Center is a warehouse where health kits, flood buckets, and other disaster relief supplies are prepared, stored, and distributed on behalf of UMCOR in addition to several other ministries.

Volunteers will have a variety of options, including assembling relief kits, repairing bikes and sewing machines, building desks, sewing hospital gowns, etc. Some jobs can be done while seated. If you are interested in participating, please sign up in Ball Lounge by April 15th so that we can determine whether we need to explore the possibility of reserving more beds.
